## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The tender shall be submitted under two cover system as described below:  
The 1<sup>st</sup> envelope marked envelope No. 1 shall contain the following:
  - a. Earnest money deposit as per annexure in shape of FDR/ CDR pledged in favour of accounts Officer JKPCC Ltd., Jammu.
  - b. Sale tax registration No./ Tin No. & Pan No.
  - c. Copies of allotment of the same items/ works, the tenderer has been awarded by different departments alongwith value of work done.
  - d. Certificate from the Officer not less than the rank of Executive Engineer having executed the allotted work satisfactorily.
  - e. Job mix formula.
- 2) The second envelope clearly marked envelope No. 2 should only contain the rate quoted and nothing else. This envelop of only those tenders will be opened who fulfill the requirement as mentioned for envelope No. 1.
- 3) Both the envelops No. 1 & 2 shall be provided in the main envelope which shall have the name of work, date of opening of tenders mentioned on it.
- 4) The General Manager shall be at liberty to accept or reject the tenders without assigning any reason.
- 5) Successful tenderers shall have to draw necessary agreement with the corporation on the prescribed agreement form within seven days from the date of issuance of allotment order.
- 6) In case of any dispute between the firm and the corporation the matter shall be subject to arbitration and the Managing Director, JKPCC Ltd. shall be sole Arbitrator who's decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- 7) All disputes shall be subject to Jurisdiction of Jammu city courts only.
- 8) Corrections or insertions in the tender form other than rates quoted shall be properly initiated. However, the rate should not have any correction.
- 9) In case the successful tenderer / tenderers fails to fulfill the commitment in full or in the part, the JKPCC Ltd. will make alternative arrangement for the same at the risk & cost of successful tenderer.
- 10) The material should conform to standard specifications. Substandard material shall be rejected out rightly and no claim of the firm / supplier shall be entertained at any cost.
- 11) Tender documents requested by mail will be dispatched by Registered Post/Speed Post on payment of an extra amount of Rs 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only). The JKPCC will not be responsible for the postal delay, if any, in the delivery of the documents or non-receipt of the same.
- 12) The rates should be quoted on the Annexure enclosed both in figures and words and should be inclusive of all sorts of taxes as applicable.
- 13) The rates quoted shall be inclusive of All Taxes i.e. Royalty, Toll Tax, Sales Tax, Octri Charges and any other local tax in the area & nothing extra shall be paid over and above the allotted rates.
- 14) Taxes viz. Income Tax, Service Tax, Cess shall be deducted at the prevailing rates from the bill.
- 15) Security deposit @ 5% shall be deducted from the each running bill and shall be released only after completion of defect liability period which shall be 06 months from the date of completion of work.

- 16) In case of unscheduled holiday on the prescribed date of tender sale, closing date/receipt of the tender date, the next working day shall be treated as the scheduled prescribed day of the corresponding event.
- 17) Conditional tender will be rejected without giving any reasons.
- 18) The tenders shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the stipulated date of submission or as per discretion of accepting officer.
- 19) The tenderer should sign all the pages and tender document before submission of the tender.
- 20) The tender issuing authority reserves the right to refuse to issue tender documents to any supplier / firm if not satisfied with their proof of eligibility with out assigning any reason thereof.
- 21) The tenders received after the fixed date and time shall neither be opened nor considered at all. The date and time of receipt of such tenders would be marked on the envelope by tender receiving authority of this office representative. The disposal of the tender document will either be returned to the supplier / firm casting the tender of earnest money released, but this will be done only after the concerned gives an undertaking for any of these two clauses clearly mentioning that he would have no claim what so ever over this contract. In case the tenderer does not come forward with the undertaking the envelope will remain in safe custody till its final disposal. However this will not bar the department to process further in the matter to open other bids / allot the contract and take-up the supply.
- 22) Tenderers shall not be entitled to any claim what so ever on account of expenses incurred on submission of tender.
- 23) The contractor shall also be personally liable for the civil and criminal prosecution under the law if the specification of the supplied material used are found in contravention to the specification prescribed during execution of the work even after the completion and finalization of contract i.e at any time.
- 24) If Engineer Incharge feels that the contractor to whom the work is allotted is not in a position to complete the work in time, He shall have right to place the order to other agency on the same rate / terms and conditions to complete the work.
