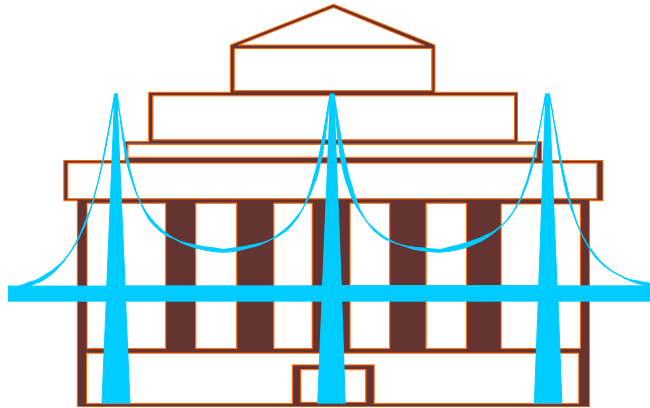

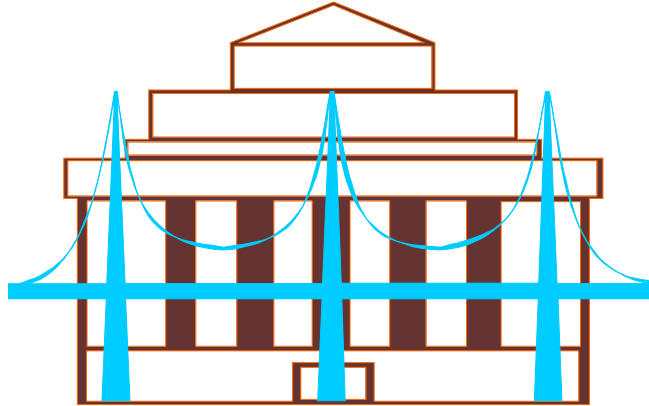

ABBREVIATED NIT

- 1) For and on behalf of the Managing Director, JKPCC Ltd., sealed tenders affixed with Rupees Five Revenue Stamps are invited from the Original manufacturers/dealers or their representatives duly authorised by the manufacturing firms for supply of Stage furnishing for Auditorium at Sainik School Nagrota, Jammu. (As per Drawing). As per Annexure 'A'. The tenders should reach by registered post/speed post/courier in the office of the Managing Director, JKPCC Ltd., Baba Ambedkar Chowk, Rail Head Complex Jammu on or before 24/9/2011 upto 2 P.M. The tenders will be opened on the same date or any other subsequent date as convenient to the Managing Director in presence of tenders, who may like to be present at the time of opening of the tenders.
- 2) The tenders should be accompanied with earnest money in shape of CDR/FDR for the amount indicated in the Annexure of this NIT against each item pledged to the Accounts Officer, JKPCC Ltd., Jammu drawn at any scheduled bank towards the amount of earnest money, tenders not accompanied with EMD will be liable for rejection.
- 3) The tender should quote their rates for supply of Stage furnishing for Auditorium at Sainik School Nagrota, Jammu. (As per rate list).
- 4) There shall be no liability on the corporation to pay any interest on the FDR/CDR.
- 5) The successful tenderer/tenderers shall have to execute the work according to design/drawings and specification approved by project authority.
- 6) In case the successful tenderer/tenderers fails to execute the work according to the specification and within the time or backs-out from the contract, the corporation shall terminate the contract and recover the extra cost involved from defaulting tenderer/tenderers. In addition to this his earnest money shall be forfeited and penalty may be imposed upto 10% (ten percent) at the discretion of the Managing Director.
- 7) In case the materials used are found to be sub-standard, it shall be responsibility of the manufacturers/firm to remove the sub-standard materials immediately from the site of work and in the event of failure of the successful tenderer/tenderers to do the same, it shall be

removed by the corporation itself from the site of work and cost of removing material shall be debited to the account of the defaulters.

- 8) Successful tenderer/tenderers shall have to draw necessary agreement with the corporation on the prescribed agreement form within seven days from the date of issuance of allotment order.
- 9) Corrections or insertions in the tender other than rates shall be properly initiated however, the rates should not have any correction.
- 10) The Managing Director, reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 11) In case of any dispute between the manufacturer/authorized dealer/contractor and the Corporation the matter shall be subject to arbitration and the Managing director, JKPCC Ltd., shall be the sole arbitrator who's decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- 12) Tenderers are requested to obtain the tender documents from the office of the Dy. General Manager, JKPCC Ltd., Unit 3rd, Baba Ambedkar Chowk, Rail Head complex Jammu after submitting their applications with documents duly attested for proof of their being manufacturer or authorized dealer for the make specified against a cash payment of Rs.500/- (Non-refundable) during working hours upto 20/9/2011 upto 4 P.M.
- 13) Conditional tenders will be rejected without assigning any reasons.
- 14) In case of an unscheduled holiday on the prescribed tender sale closing date/receipt date of the tender. The next working day shall be treated as the schedule prescribed day of the Corresponding event.
- 15) The tenderer shall sign all the pages and tender documents before submission of the tender.
- 16) The tenders shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days (ninety days) from date of opening of the tender.
- 17) Work shall be completed within 20 days time from the date of allotment.

Instruction for submitting tender:-

The tender shall be submitted under two cover system as described below:-

The first envelope clearly marked "ENVELOPE No.1" should only include the following;-

- i)* Earnest money deposit as per Annexure in shape of CDR/FDR pledged in favour of Accounts Officer, JKPCC Ltd., Jammu.
- ii)* Sales Tax Registration No. TIN No. certificate/ I.T assessment latest.
- iii)* List of value of material in stock at the time of tendering.

- iv)* Copies of allotment orders for the same nature of work, the tenderer has been awarded by the different departments in the last 2 years alongwith completion & turnover duly certified by a person not less than rank of Ex. Engineer.
- v)* Attested copy of a documentary evidence that the firm is representative of particular company & can execute the job on their behalf.
- vi)* The tender document should be submitted alongwith the sample of the item/items tendered.

The second envelope clearly marked "ENVELOPE.2" should only contain the prices/rate quoted and nothing else. The rates quoted should be in the format specified annexure enclosed with the tender documents.
